Dear Students, Parents and Carers,

Teaching arrangements up until the end of the year

This week marks the end of the month-long dawn-to-sunset fasting of Ramadan. Although many of our students will be celebrating the religious holiday of Eid al-Fitr, college will remain open for students wishing to attend their timetabled sessions as normal. Students celebrating Eid will have their absence authorised for two days, so as not to affect their overall attendance.

Y12 A level and BTEC lessons will continue up to and including Tuesday 22 June. College will be closed on Wednesday 23 June and as a result will be a revision day for all Y12 students.

Y12 progression exams will be taking place in the sports hall from Thursday 24 June until Wednesday 30 June. Y12 students will be on study leave over this period, only attending college for their exams or if their subject teacher has organised to deliver a revision session. Exam timetables will soon be available on each student's exam page on Cedar.

Once Y12 students have finished their progression exams, they will not have to be in college again until progression day on Friday 9 July. On progression day, students will receive their progression exam results in each of their subjects and discuss their progression into Y13. It is vitally important that students prepare well for these exams, as it may well affect their progression into Y13.

I hope this information has been helpful. I will keep you updated with further information and guidance where appropriate, especially as we approach the Y12 progression exams in the summer. For now, I encourage students to keep smiling and to keep working hard during these final few weeks.
