CEDAR Access Is Changing!

For the benefit of new parents/carers, CEDAR is the online portal used to communicate crucial information about the progress and attendance of students, alongside a host of other features. This is your first port of call to see comments from teachers, study support and progress tutors and you can also make contact via CEDAR. It's a really effective way for you to feel more informed about the learning journey.

From Monday 27 September, the way parents/carers access CEDAR is changing. From this date, all access will take place via your own CEDAR account that you set up using your personal email address stored on our College records.

If the email address and reference match our records, an email will be sent to you with a link to finalise creating your account by setting a password.







