Dear Students, Parents and Carers,

This year A Level and Applied General results will be available to collect from **8:00 am** until **10:30am** in the Sports Hall on **Thursday 18 August**. GCSE Maths results will be available to view on Cedar from **8:30am** on **Thursday 25 August**.

If you are planning to go to university, you can see the status of your offers by logging on to **UCAS Track** from **8:15am** on results day. This will tell you whether you have secured your Firm or Insurance choice. You should check this before doing anything else as sometimes universities will still accept students if they don't meet all of the entry requirements. If you don't meet the entry requirements, universities may also make an alternative offer to you for a different course on results day, which you can see on UCAS Track. You can see more information about the different statuses that will show on results day <u>here</u>. You should also check your email address that you provided to UCAS, as universities may contact you that way.

If you don't meet your entry requirements, or if you don't currently have an offer, you can apply for places using the **Clearing system**. By logging on, you can see which universities and courses have places to offer. You should check the entry requirements and then contact the university directly to discuss options with them.

When you come into college to collect your results, staff will be on hand to help with these processes and to offer additional support.

If you are unable to collect your results in person, you have three options:

- Leave an A4 stamped addressed envelope with the Exams Office so that your results can be posted.
- Nominate another person to collect your results by sending an email to our Exams Officer, Sarah Pinkney (sarah.pinkney@nclt.ac.uk), saying who you wish to collect your results. The nominated person must provide photo ID such as a driving licence or passport when collecting your results.
- Wait until **9.00am** on **Friday 19 August** when all A Level and Applied General results will be available to view on Cedar. If you have any difficulties accessing Cedar during the holidays, please visit <u>https://nclt.ac.uk/itfaqs/</u> for help.
