Dear Parent

My name is Jim Welford and I teach GCSE maths to your son or daughter.

Students will be sitting GCSE resit in November on the following dates

- Paper 1 - Tuesday 1st November
- Paper 2 - Thursday 3rd November
- Paper 3 - Monday 7th November

All exams start at 9:00 am and students are expected to arrive 15 minutes before, at the usual start time of 8:45am.

They now have a two week period of independent study; to achieve their best grade they need to be doing as much Maths as possible over this time.

The awarding body have given advance notice of the topics that are on the exam and lessons and provision of resources have been focused on these. All students have been supplied with past paper questions and are aware that additional resources and lessons are to be found on Teams.

### Websites

We are fortunate to benefit from student subscriptions to several Maths websites. Some of these we use to set and monitor homework tasks; some are for students to use for independent study; some are made available to every Maths student; some are used to provide targeted support for certain students.
