Background/Context

*A clear understanding of human biology is essential for most health care professions, and this unit lays the groundwork for your studies in careers such as nursing, midwifery or the allied health professions. Equally, if you are looking to enter the workforce, knowledge of human biology is beneficial to those working in supportive roles in the health and social care sector. **There are 4 tasks for you to complete below.***

A4: Homeostasis

Homeostasis keeps the body's internal conditions constant so cells can function normally and avoid damage.

Negative feedback is a control process that keeps a mechanism in the body, like temperature, within a set range. When a change in the condition is detected, it triggers a response that reverses the change and restores the condition to its normal level.

TASK 1: Produce THREE separate negative feedback loops on the following:

- Thermoregulation
- Osmoregulation
- Blood glucose regulation

B2: Respiratory System

The respiratory system allows oxygen in the air to enter the body, and to be taken up by cells and tissues. The respiratory system also eliminates carbon dioxide from the body.

TASK 2: Label a diagram and explain the function of the following parts of the respiratory system:

- Pharynx
- Larynx
- Trachea
- Bronchus/Bronchioles
- Alveoli
- Lungs
- Diaphragm
- Intercostal muscles

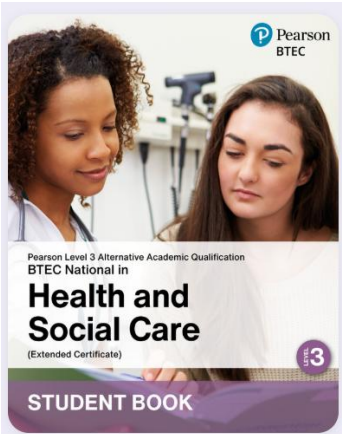

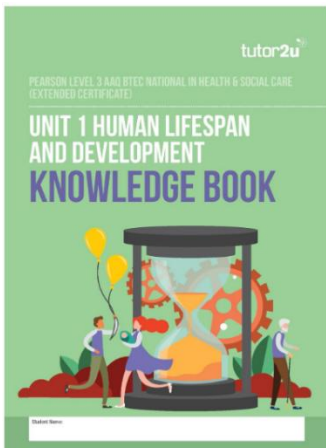

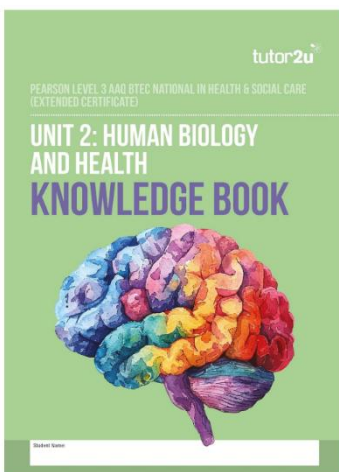
